



Race Instructions

8-2-2015

Schedule:

Packet Pickup 5:30am -7:00am

7:10am - Line up – 26 mile race, 50 mile tour and then 26 mile tour.

7:20am – Pre-Race Meeting and Instructions

7:30am – Start

Packet Pickup: *All participants must read and sign waiver, download from website to save time. You will also be able to sign up in person at packet pickup locations.*

Directions to San Marcos River Ranch: Directions to River Ranch: From IH35 head east on Hwy 123. Travel ¼ mile and then left on FM621/Staples Road. Travel 3.6 miles and then left on Scull Road. Travel 2.7 miles on Scull road and then take a right into the River Ranch Sub-division.

Parking: After you enter the sub division, you will turn right at the stop sign and proceed around the lakes and then follow the signs to a large grassy area. We will have volunteers and sign directing you.

Routes: Please review online maps and familiarize yourself with the routes. For the 26 mile route, there will be Police at all intersections where left hand turns are made. You still must obey traffic laws and Police. The route ***is not*** closed to vehicular traffic so you must stay on the right side of the road and be attentive at all times on these rural roads. The 50 mile Tour is a ride on rural roads and open to vehicular traffic. You must obey all traffic laws and stop at all lights and stop signs. **The Police are not at the intersections on this route.** You must exercise caution at all times. Aid stations will be on-route as well as Portable toilets.

Tour Participants: You will also receive a small yellow license plate with a chip, this is for tracking.

Race Format: Each 26 mile race participant will receive a small yellow license plate bib that will be attached to the front of the bike by wire ties. The bib number must be orientated to the front. The timing chip will be attached to this bib. The Jalapeno race participants will be given a wrist band and when they eat Jalapenos at each aid station that number will be written on the wrist band. After the participant finishes under the archway they must go to the timing trailer and give the wrist band to the official timer to receive credit for time deductions. Jalapeno aid stations are at mile 7 and mile 17.

Awards: 26 Mile Jalapeno Race and Regular race. Age groups awards 3 deep Male and Female. Age groups are 0-19 and then in 5 year increments.

Post Race: Serving the World Famous Kielbassa Sausage wraps in 3 different flavors under the towering Pecan Trees next to the San Marcos River.
